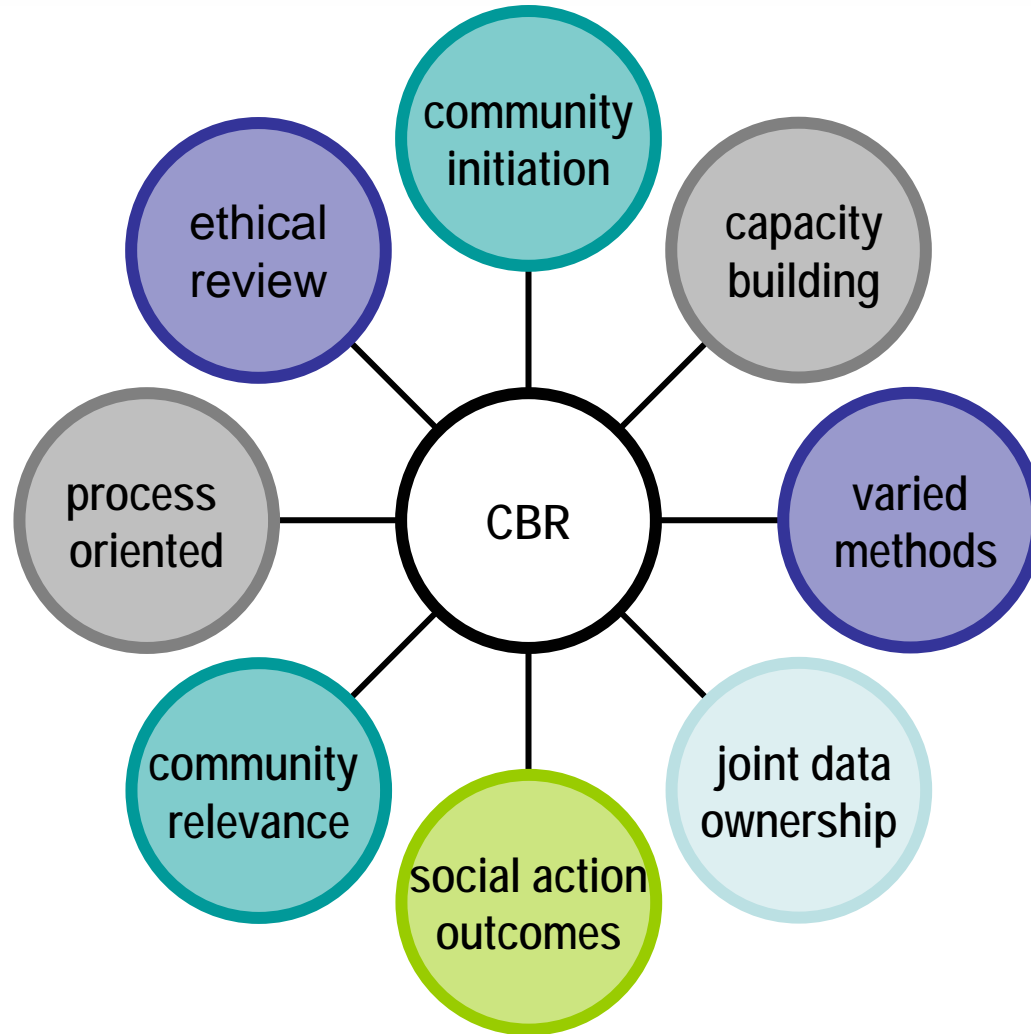
Making the data come to life
